#### MONOM

(Handbag)

*A Monom is made of Onomen which is the main materials for making this handicraft. It comes with different style such as handbag (kamfilu), sling bag (Talufi), and backpack (Bokog).*



## KONGO

(Basket)

*Traditional baskets kongo are still of the same materials of old, like nito, pawa (a thin and light kind of bamboo), and teel (a kind of rattan) for rims. These baskets are still being used in Tiruray households.*





## NIGO

*This what makes their nigo different. The aesthetic design of it that also made of Onomen, Gito and Grana which is use to make this colorful geometrical design. They usually called it Decorative Nigo as it can used as decorations and other aesthetical purposes.*

## **Biton**

*Biton is a flat round-shaped rice winnower, a traditional kitchen material. Teduray women use a biton to “turn” (toss) white rice grains on it for the purpose of removing unwanted particles, like small stones.*

## **Senafeng**

Senafeng is one of the stacking baskets of the Teduray family where they store milled rice. Unlike other baskets, senafeng has no cover.
